



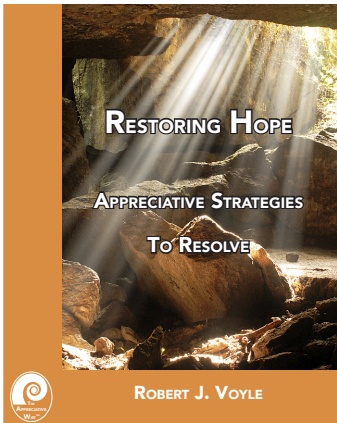

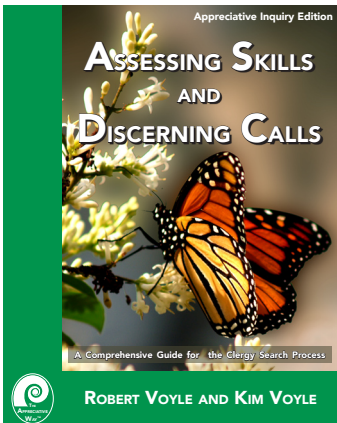

- ◆ Respond appreciatively to congregational resistance and conflict.

UNDERSTANDING THE APPRECIATIVE WAY AND TRANSFORMATION

"Jesus didn't come that we might have less death, he came that we might have life."

Too often we spend our time engaged in change processes that, at best, are stop-gap measures to delay death. What the church needs today is not change but transformation — a new way of seeing and being in the world.

The **Appreciative Way** is an intentional and strategic way of engaging in transformation by discovering and growing what is life-giving to the congregation.
